### DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE

**Course identification, length and regulatory drivers:** The following is a driver safety course outline to comply with California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Section 3203.

**Class length:** 2.5 hours

**Attendance prerequisites:** None

**Target audience:** Employees who drive Company vehicles.

**Learning objectives:** To motivate participants to change their behind-the-wheel behaviors and attitudes. Provide key skills and techniques to avoid collisions and become a more responsible driver who grasps best practices to prevent injury and death while operating a motor vehicle.

**Reference and instruction materials:** Driver safety handout, DVD and PowerPoint presentation.

**Testing:** Knowledge-based (questions to students during the course), Application-based (learning activities, pares, small group, etc.)

**Sequence of Instruction:**

- The strategies, causes, and prevention of collisions.
- How to reduce collision risk with defensive driving strategies.
- Understanding how driving distractions affect driving ability.
- The definition of impairment and its dangers.
- The impact of physical, weather, road and traffic conditions.
- How to identify and minimize aggressive driving activities.
- Parking and parking lot hazards.
- Expanded instruction on roadway markings.
- Handling vehicle breakdowns.
- The four fatal driving behaviors.
